Introduction


The Cliffhanger Promotions Inc. annual Cliffhanger Hillclimb will take place on

- **Saturday 21st March 2020** and
- **Sunday 22nd March 2020**

This document will provide you with information on how the event will be run, the stuff we need you to do and the fees you must pay.

Location

The hillclimb will take place at Tupurupuru Te Wharau Road, Gladstone, Carterton. Just off the junction with Te Whiti Road. (LAT/LON -41.0690550, 175.6664765)



What to Expect

A 6.1Km sealed hillclimb with 27 corners. A fun day with no pressure to go faster than you feel comfortable. Think of it as a road ride with no speed limit. We will still run the event if it's windy and/or wet. By mid-afternoon you may have had more runs than you can handle.

Saturday – Fun Day

Saturday will take the form of a non-competitive Fun Day, with open entry and none of the times recorded counting towards the class scoring. It is a chance for casual riders to test themselves and their bike against the hill without the worry of oncoming traffic or for the more serious riders to practise at race speeds before the main event on Sunday.

During this day it will be possible to do guided runs (un-timed) led by experienced riders with an analysis after the run for a small fee.

Sunday – The King of the Cliffhanger

Sunday is the day of the 'The King of the Cliffhanger competition with timings counting towards placings and trophies in each of the championship classes (see below for more details).

King of the Cliffhanger Classes

The King of the Cliffhanger competition is *expected* to be made up of the following classes:

We require a minimum of 6 entries for each class. We *may* run other classes (e.g. Pre 89, 400 twins etc) based on entries received

Please note that a machine can only be entered in one class but a rider may submit multiple entries for different machines. In the case of multiple entries in different classes the highest entry fee is paid (only one entry fee is payable).

What to Bring

- Full face helmet, back protector and protective clothing. A motorcycle. Road legal, unregistered, race, sidecars, cruisers etc are all welcome but your bike must be safe with no oil or coolant leaks. Essentially, bar lights and indicators, it must be “roadworthy” and not stupidly loud.
- Enough fuel for the event.
- A sober, drug free rider.
- Fold out seats.
- Sunblock & plenty of water.
- A sidestand puck/pad or similar as you will probably be parking on grass.
- If your bike has no stand, we’d suggest a spare stand so you can get off your bike at the top.
- A good attitude

No Back Protector – No Ride

Accommodation, Food & Drink

Free camping is available at the site on Friday and Saturday night. Portaloos and cold water will be provided. The Greytown Hotel (22 mins) is a major sponsor and offer discounted accommodation for this event. A number of competitors and marshals meet there on Sunday after the event.

A coffee and burger van will be available during the event on Saturday and Sunday

Masterton (15 mins) and Carterton (20 mins) are the closest towns with a number of supermarkets and restaurants.

Spectators

Spectating at the event is free.

MOTOR SPORT IS DANGEROUS – For your safety please spectate only from safe, designated areas and comply with instructions from our marshals.

Under no circumstances must the road be entered whilst the road is closed.

When the road is open to normal two way traffic, there will be a courtesy vehicle to/from safe spectating positions (gold coin donation). To minimise disruption, the courtesy bus will normally only travel in one direction between runs and only stop when requested.

Road Opening

Between runs, the road is open to normal two way traffic. Please **do not drive/ride on the wrong side of the road**. Please respect normal road rules, local residents, other road users and stick to the speed limit. Please do not stop on the road nor dawdle as this causes additional delays to the event.

Surrounding residents are nice enough to put up with motorcycle noise and disruption for 2 days of the year so please be polite to them. Please, ***no practise runs prior to the event*** as this could lead to future events being restricted.

No back protector, No ride

We have strict standards for riding gear and all riders must wear a back protector:
We do have a limited number of them available for hire. Please see the online copy of the indemnity form for details of the minimum protective gear required.

Terms of Entry and Indemnity

1. I understand and accept that Motorcycle Competition can be dangerous and may;
 - a. Cause me injury, serious or otherwise;
 - b. Damage my property.
2. I agree that in the context of this agreement, that 'my property' includes any property owned by me or in my possession or under my control.
3. Neither I, nor anyone associated or connected with me, will make any claim against Cliffhanger Promotions Inc., their officers, employees or agents (hereon collectively referred to as Cliffhanger) in respect of;
4. Any injury suffered by me;
5. Any damage to any of my property regardless of how the injury or damage occurs.
6. I will release, hold harmless and indemnify Cliffhanger against all claims, damages and losses (including costs) that they may incur as the direct or indirect result of any injury to me or damage to my property.
7. I am aware that this indemnity will not affect any legal obligations that Cliffhanger have to me have to me which they cannot contract out of under New Zealand Law.
8. I agree that this agreement and indemnity will be binding on my family, my heirs, my legal assigns and my administrators and executors.
9. I am physically fit and there is no health or other reason why I should not participate in the sport of Motorcycle Competition.
10. I attest that I am a competent motorcycle rider and have the necessary skills to participate safely in this event.
11. I understand that back-protectors are mandatory and I will wear one at all times when riding on the course.
12. I am responsible at all times for the condition and safety of my motorcycle and riding gear/helmet.
13. I confirm that my protective gear meets or exceeds the following minimum requirements:
 - a. Back Protector (limited numbers are available for hire).
 - b. Leather or Kevlar one piece suits, or
 - c. Leather or Kevlar two-piece suit with concealed joining zip, or
 - d. Leather or Kevlar Jacket and Bib type pants. The Bib must extend as far as the riders Sternum when standing.
 - e. Leather gloves with adjustable restraint type wrist band.
 - f. Leather boots that extend above the ankle. Must be zipped, buckled or laced. No motocross boots unless these are closed by zip, buckle or laced.
 - g. Snug fitting undamaged helmet, full face, with a strap retaining system, less than 10 years old (recommend less than 5 years), that complies with one or more of the approved international standards:
 - i. UN/ECE Regulation No. 22-04 or 22-05: Protective helmets and their visors for drivers and passengers of motorcycles and mopeds (Europe)
 - ii. Australian Standard AS 1698: 2006 Protective helmets for vehicle users
 - iii. New Zealand Standard NZS 5430: Protective helmets for vehicle users
 - iv. Snell Memorial Foundation: M 2000 or M 20005 – 2010 Helmet Standard for use in motorcycling
 - v. Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 218: Motorcycle helmets
 - vi. British Standard BS 6658: Specification for protective helmets for vehicle users (for type A helmets only)
 - vii. Japan Industrial Standard T8133:2000.
14. I will not, under any circumstances, allow anyone not registered for this event to ride my motorcycle at this event.
15. I will attend the morning riders' briefing on all days that I participate in the event.
16. I will obey all instructions given to me by Cliffhanger, both verbal and non-verbal (for example, flags), whilst taking part in this event.
17. I will not take part in this event whilst under the influence of drugs or alcohol. I understand that Cliffhanger supports the FIM/IOC Charter on drugs in Sport and that Cliffhanger will use the services of the NZ Drug Sports Agency (NZDSA) to professionally carry out drug/alcohol testing. I acknowledge, by signing this form, I may be subjected to a drug/alcohol test at any time. I agree to such testing.
18. I understand that my entry to this event may be immediately cancelled without refund if Cliffhanger has reasonable grounds to believe that any of the terms 9 to 17 above have been breached.
19. I accept that stripping and re-assembly for Technical Checks are at my cost.
20. I consent to the details contained in this form being held by Cliffhanger, for the purpose of the promotion and benefit of the race meeting concerned, and Motorcycling in general. I acknowledge my right to access and correction of this information. This consent is given in accordance with the privacy Act, 1993.
21. I understand that entries to this event may be limited for organisational reasons and that Cliffhanger are under no obligation to accept my entry.
22. I understand that if there are insufficient entries in a class, Cliffhanger have the right to cancel or combine a class.
23. I understand that refunds, for whatever reason, are at the sole discretion of Cliffhanger and that Cliffhanger will not enter into any correspondence with regard to any claim that may arise from my participation in this event.
24. I certify that the information provided on the entry form is correct.
